Branding Identity and Applications

Project Objective:

To create a branding identity and visual applications for an entertainment district located in downtown Savannah, GA.

Concept:

Focusing on the Starland District in Savannah, the goal was to elevate it to the same level as Broughton and River Street, making it known to tourists. The design of the logo is inspired by the old Starland Dairy red star.

Components:

Pairing with the logo created for the Starland District, multiple applications were created. This includes a poster series that promotes upcoming events in the Starland District, a brochure with places to eat, shop, visit, and drink that would be placed in hotels, a website with information about the Starland District, Instagram posts to promote businesses, and merchandise. New signage was also created to direct visitors to different restaurants and shops, as well as projection mapping video displayed in Starland Yard, enhancing the space.

Although being a major tourist destination, the city of Savannah does not currently have an entertainment district. The goal of this project is to highlight an area of Savannah that could be made into an Entertainment district for the cities residents and visitors.
